Theatre Group to present "Our Town"

For their fourth production of the season, the Kanata Theatre Group will present OUR TOWN, Thornton Wilder's moving play set in a small New England community early in this century. Since 1944, when it was first produced on Broadway, OUR TOWN has continued to be popular with drama groups and audiences, depicting as it does

the simple events of human life transformed into what the New York Times called "a hauntingly beautiful play". It has been described as one of the most important theatrical experiences of this generation, written with straightforward simplicity, sincerity and compassionate understanding.

The production will be presented in Stephen Leacock School at 8:30 p.m. on Friday and Saturday, February 26 and 27. Tickets can be obtained from any member of the Theatre Group, or at the advance boxoffice in the Kanata Mall on Saturday, February 26th, or at the school before the performances.
