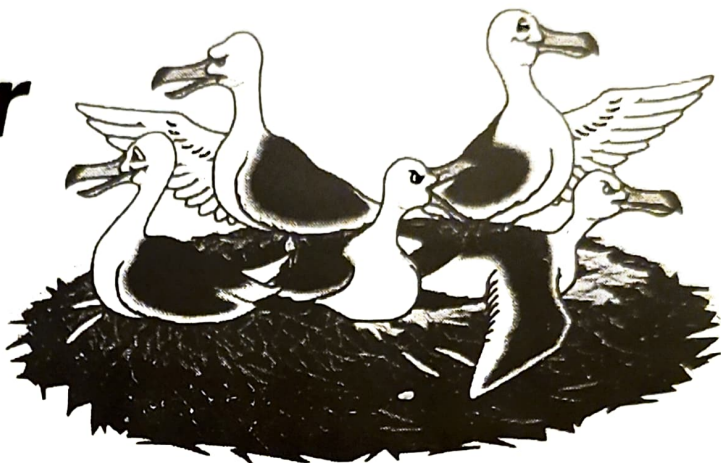

Cast

GWENDY TOLLEY (*Helene*) made her acting debut with Kanata Theatre playing Myrtle Mae in *Harvey*. Some of the productions she has appeared in since include Twelfth Night, Critic's Choice, Quiet in the Land, 84 Charing Cross Road, Look No Hans, Shadow Box, Steel Magnolias, It Runs in the Family and last season's A Month of Sundays. More often, Gwendy can be found backstage in the role of Stage Manager or Producer.

DAVID LAVOIE (*George*) has been in a number of Kanata Theatre plays. Among his roles are the police sergeant in It Runs in the Family, Gordon Lowther in The Prime of Miss Jean Brodie, Father Ambrose in The Waltz of the Toreadors and Antonio in Much Ado About Nothing. He has also served on the Board of Directors of Kanata Theatre, chairing the committee which selected the plays for this season.

GREG WINKLEMAIER (*Keith*) appears on Kanata Theatre's stage for the first time. Recently, he donned costume and wig and assisted with the Wedding Palace Bridal Show's Prince in Quest of a Princess as an "eighteenth century gentleman". He also worked with the Orpheus group as a stage hand for the production of The Music Man.

JAMES RUSSELL (*Michael*) has played Algernon Moncrieff in The Importance of Being Earnest and a happy-go-lucky surgeon in It Runs in the Family. James has also appeared in The Melville Boys, Lost in Yonkers, As You Like It, The Real Thing and Of the Fields Lately. He co-directed Kanata Student Summer Theatre's Salt Water Moon. As an Earl of March student, he starred in Joseph and His Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat.

BRETT KELLY (*Elliott*) went from being a punk rocker in It Runs in the Family to the magnificent Jack Worthing in The Importance of Being Earnest, Kipps in The Woman in Black, Quinn in The Affections of May and Conrade in this season's Much Ado About Nothing. He was also in Kanata Theatre's Christmas Adventure and The Mirrorman. Brett is currently majoring in Theatre at the University of Ottawa, and this year wrote and directed Kanata Theatre's Christmas play, Hansel and Gretel: A Christmas Story.

TRACY ZINCK (*Janie*) was born and raised in Kitchener Ontario, where her main interest was performing as a gymnast. She has been living in Ottawa for over ten years. This is Tracy's debut performance on Kanata Theatre's stage.

SHELAGH MILLS (*Director*) This is the first play that Shelagh has directed at Kanata Theatre.
