Mauritius by Theresa Rebeck

When her mother dies after an expensive illness and a lifetime of bad choices, young Jackie is left with a mound of debt. One glimmer of hope: a stamp collection, potentially valuable, is amongst her assets. Trouble brews and the game is on in this dark, edgy suspenseful tour de force. Its plot twists will leave the audience gasping for breath.



Brighton Beach Memoirs by Neil Simon

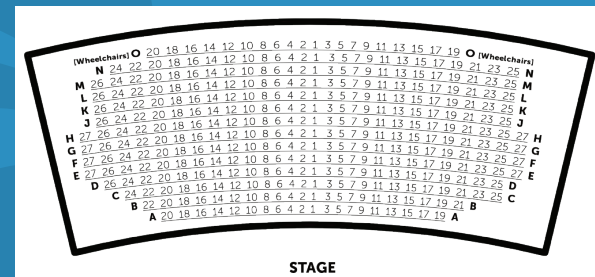

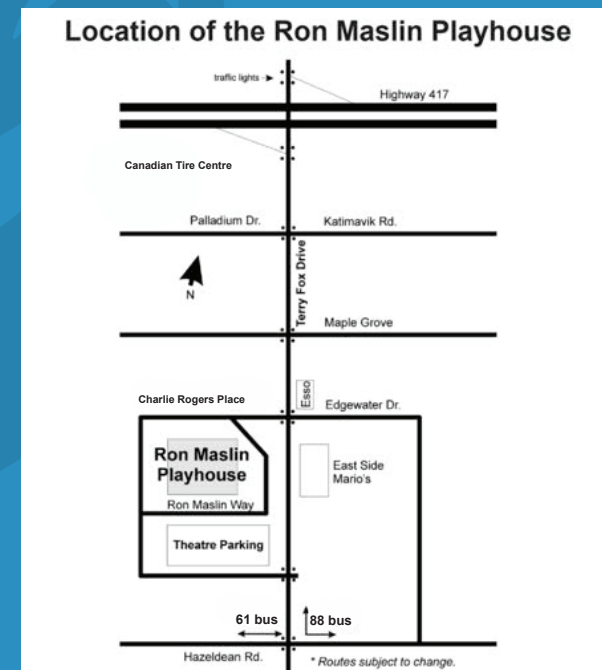
The Ron Maslin Playhouse is a modern 350-seat theatre situated just off Terry Fox Drive, south of the Queensway in Kanata.
